# **ASSEMBLY BILL 306**

California Recently passed Assembly Bill 306 which addresses school enrollment for active duty military families. This bill prohibits a school district of residence from prohibiting the transfer of a pupil who is a child of an active duty parent to a school in any school district, if the school district to which the parents of the pupil apply approves the application for transfer.

- Parent/Guardian Employment
- Childcare
- Specialized Programs
- Sibling Attendance

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- 1. Complete the Interdistrict Permit Application and supporting documents for Outgoing Students at your home school district of residence.
- 2. Keep a copy of the confirmation for your records.
- Check your email inbox, spam, or junk email regularly for correspondence from the school district.
- 4. Take the Permit Approval Form to the gaining school district.
